



## New Milwaukee Public Market creates shopping sensation

WHILE THE seasonal farmers' market of the Milwaukee Public Market opened July 15, the year-round indoor market just opened to rave reviews last month. This new year-round addition to the Milwaukee scene offers seafood, poultry and meats; local and organic produce; baked goods; desserts; flowers; cheese; coffee; chocolates and confections; ethnic specialties; spices, herbs and seasonings.

Located at 400 N. Water St., the Milwaukee Public Market is in walking distance of downtown hotels and businesses. There is an adjacent surface lot, ample free street parking in the adjacent Historic Third Ward and two parking garages at 212 N. Milwaukee St. and 255 E. Chicago St.

Visit the seasonal farm stalls every weekend, 8 a.m.-1 p.m. Saturday and Sunday through Nov. 13. Inside, there are 17 unique, year-round specialty market food vendors. Hours for the indoor market are 10 a.m.-7 p.m., Tuesday through Friday and 8 a.m.-4 p.m. Saturday and Sunday during the fall. (Closed on Monday.)

On the mezzanine level are tables and a demonstration area. A state-of-the-art demonstration kitchen will host 60-minute "Traffic Jam Classes" at 5:30 p.m. on Nov. 1, 2, 9, 10, 15, 17, 29 and 30. Phone 414-289-3108 to register for the \$10 classes.
